The Corinthian Yacht Club of Philadelphia Junior Sailing Camp 2024



The Junior Sailing Program at The Corinthian Yacht Club of Philadelphia continues to grow and expand sailing opportunities for the youth of the club and the Philadelphia area. The Corinthian Yacht Club of Philadelphia invites children ages 8 through 17 to discover the joy of sailing.

Our objective is to provide a fun summer camp experience while teaching sailing and boating.

Sailing Camp, (C1-6): Six week-long sessions from Monday, June 17th through Friday, July 26th. The camp starts at 9:00 AM and ends at 4:00 PM each day. Lunch is included.

Race Camp, (R1&2): We offer a 2-week ADVANCED course for young sailors looking to sharpen their racing skills, starting Monday, July 15th and ending Friday, July 26th, from 9:00 AM-4:00 PM each day, with lunch included. The ADVANCED sessions are designed to introduce and refine racing concepts and skills in 420s and Opti's for returning junior sailors and campers with sailing experience.

Frequently Asked Questions

What are the camp dates?

6 weekly sessions running from Monday, June 17th – Friday, July 26th 2-week advanced course from Monday, July 15th - Friday, July 26th

What are the camp hours?

Camp runs from 9AM -4PM. Counselors are available 8:30AM – 4:30PM for drop off and pick up.

What does the camp cost?

Cost per session: \$550 per week for members; \$700 per week for non – members.

What else does my child need to bring to camp?

Each child needs a life jacket, hat, sunscreen, shoes, towel, and bathing suit.

Does the camp provide lunch?

Yes, the camp provides lunch.

Does my child need to have sailing experience?

No experience is necessary for the Sailing Camp. Admission to the Race Camp is based on the child's prior sailing experience and is at the discretion of the Sailing Director.

Does the camp offer activities other than sailing?

Yes, we offer canoeing, kayaking, stand-up paddle boards and swimming when the wind/weather does not cooperate for sailing.

Does my child need to have a boat to attend camp?

The Yacht Club provides the boats to be used for instruction.

Does my child need to be able to swim?

Swimming is not required as every sailor is required to wear a Life Jacket whenever they are on or around the water. All campers do a swimming evaluation at the start of each weekly season.

What safety precautions can I expect while my child is on the river?

The Sailing Director is US Sailing Certified Instructor and a Certified Red Cross first aid instructor. Senior Instructors are required to be US Sailing Level 1 Certified Instructors. All counselors are required to be CPR certified. There is also a Certified Lifeguard on duty when the students are in the swimming pool.

What happens if there is inclement weather?

Camp occurs rain or shine. Indoor space is provided.
